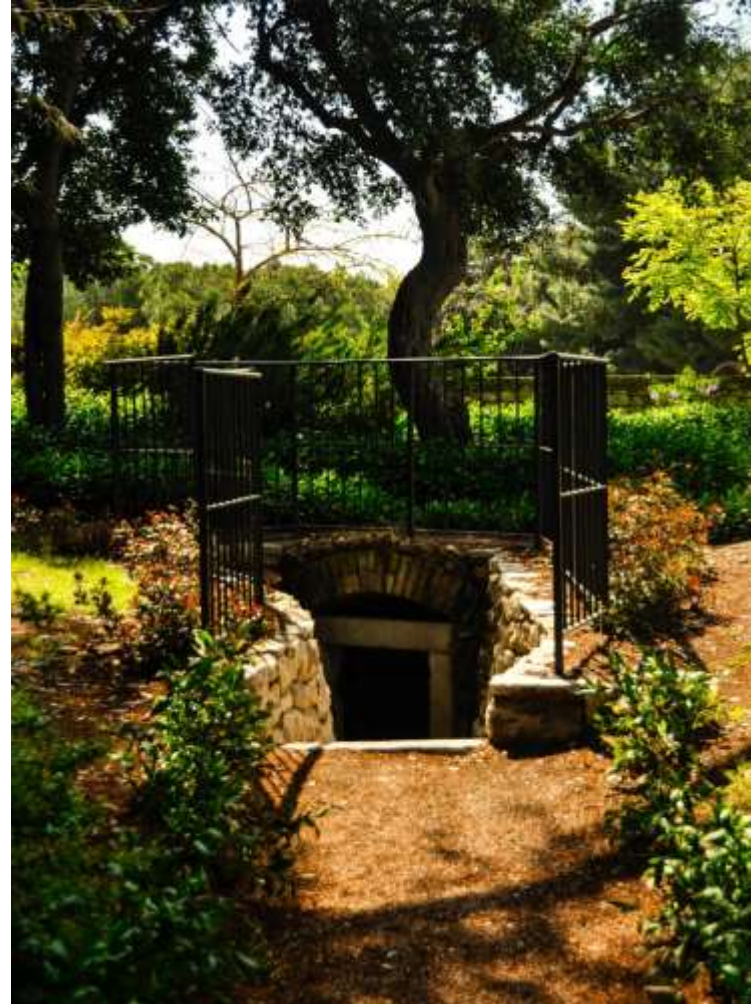
Green oasis of my town

- Owing to sixteen bronze busts of famous citizens of Zadar, placed in this park, it is also called “**Park of Glory**”.

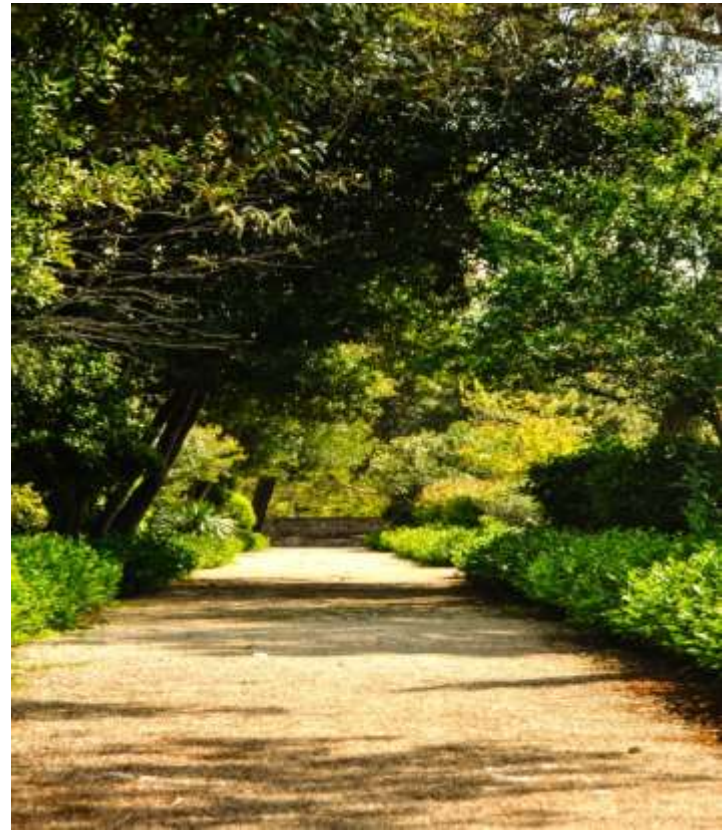


Park Vrulje
