





OPERATIONAL CONCLUSIONS OF THE 8TH TSG MEETING FOR PILLAR 4

Zagreb, Croatia, 19-20 April 2018

6 out of 8 countries participated

- nomination of TSG member responsible for cooperation within the BLUE MFD initiative
- send feedback (approval of the texts, possible additions, comments)
 on the texts for two cross-pillar projects
- confirmation/choice on the themes of the EUSAIR cultural routes that will be developed in cooperation with CoE (proposal of three possible routes, The Olive Tree Route already confirmed by TSG 4); the second route (Maritime and Coastal Heritage or the Roman Emperor Route) will be chosen by the priority of votes













Action with one month deadline

 countries will try to send some proposals (more detailed) on proposed actions of individual TSG4 members as proposed in the Executive Summary of the report on the EUSAIR national tourism strategies









Other:

- create the list of all EUSAIR planned activities in 2018 including the AI-NURECC activities (proposed by DG REGIO)
- the ideas for cross-pillar project proposals should be agreed between at least two TSGs and then put in the application form and sent to TSG4 members on 10 days approval
- the TSGs should also appoint one person responsible for each of cross-Pillar projects
- no replies from countries (after one rush note sent) will be considered as an agreement
- Montenegro will get in touch with their national coordinator for the more detailed information about upcoming Montenegrin chairmanship (proposed to host 10th TSG 4 meeting as well)
- send feedback on the proposal of time and place of the next TSG4 meeting: Mali Lošinj, back to back to the meetings organised in the framework of Croatian presidency of the Council of Europe

- For funds not spent in 2017 and 2018, countries were invited to propose activities (by the end of November)

- Routes4U: an umbrella route will be formed on the theme of ancient Roman heritage; the
 questionnaire will be circulated once again to all TSG4 members, who should distribute it on
 national level and answer it in ten days
- **EYCH**: countries were invited to send a report on EYCH activities connected to top Pillar priorities of cultural tourism, tourism and culture (deadline was 30th November).









> The cross cutting actions

- EC will disseminate the open calls for proposals and has already provided the links to a number of platforms and calls for proposal
- Countries are invited to review the executive summary, choose a theme and send their further proposals latest by 21 January 2019

> EUSAIR Facility Point

- Catania Declaration: TSGs shall identify the proposed macro-regional priorities for their respective pillar by 15 January 2019. PCs shall communicate in writing the proposed priorities to NCs by February 2019
- All are welcome to comment the »Modus Operandi« document by December 15
- Monitoring and evaluation: Questionnaire related to the M&E expert tasks is to be answered by 10 December 2019





- Italy is expected to nominate their new national level representative to TSG4.


















