


Framework

Framework Agreement on the Sava River Basin (FASRB)

Sustainable development of the region through transboundary water cooperation

- Particular objectives to establish:
 - Sustainable water management
 - Sustainable hazard management (floods, droughts, accidents, etc.)
 - International regime of **navigation**
- **ISRBC** (4 member countries + Montenegro)





Scope

- Management plans
 (river basin, flood risk, sediment, climate adaptation, contingency)
- Integrated systems

 (information, forecasting, warning)
- Economic activities

 (navigation, river tourism, ...)
- Policy
 (harmonization, policies / guidelines, protocols to FASRB)










Tourism development

Ministry declaration 2009:


Perceive great potentials for **development of tourism** in the SRB in environmentally friendly manner and *encourage* the Parties to jointly investigate the possibilities in this regard



- Nautical and tourism guide for the Sava River (2010)
- Future activities
 - Development of Master plan
 - Establishment of infrastructure (e.g. construction of floating platforms)

Transboundary Ecotourism Guidelines


Purpose

- Provide expert contribution to unified approach to sustainable development of ecotourism in wetland areas of international importance;
- Outline the scope of work for Master plan for development of ecotourism in the SRB

Scope

- sustainable management at different policy levels (international, national and local);
- technical measures to be implemented
- stakeholder involvement
- determinations of funding possibilities

Sava ECOTOUR



- Project title:
 - Transboundary Ecotourism Development using Sava River Basin as a showcase
- Initiated by ISRBC and REC
- Applicants:
 - Agency for development of SMEs of Srbac Municipality, APIS (<u>Lead Applicant</u>)
 - Public Institution Lonjsko Polje Nature Park
 - Nature conservation movement Sremska Mitrovica, SNR Zasavica
 - Public institution Ljubljana moors park
- Main objective:
 - to implement and connect wetlands alongside the Sava river through ecotourism in order to increase the touristic value of wetlands.
- Implemented in 2014/2015 through TAF

 - Promote further regional cooperation
- Roundtable (Zagreb, 7 Mar. 2017)
 - Establishment of permanet mechanizem for cooperation
 - Identification of transboundary projects
- Joint statement On regional cooperation on development of sustainable tourism in the Sava River Basin

signed (Bled, 15 June 2017)

Establisment of TTG (ISRBC Decision-15/17)



Sustainable tourism development



JOINT ACTION PLAN FOR THE SAVA RIVER BASIN

- accepted by the ISRBC in June 2017
- prepared with support of the World Bank
- a milestone for integrated river basin management and socioeconomic development in the region,
- Priority Area 4: Sustainable river tourism
 - <u>Action 4.1:</u> Development of a Sava River Nautical Way from Brežice in Slovenia to Belgrade in Serbia and integration with other sustainable tourism products, actions and activities.
 - <u>Action 4.2:</u> Development of **Transnational Sava River Bike Lane** and integration with other sustainable tourism products, actions and activities.
 - <u>Action 4.3:</u> Promotion of eco-tourism in the Sava River Ramsar sites and other protected areas and integration with other sustainable tourism products, actions and activities.
